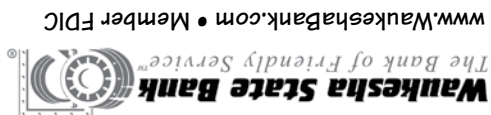

Craft Corner

Autumn Blend Crayons

Wonder what to do with all of your broken or worn down crayons? Make a one-of-a-kind fall color crayon that's fun and easy to grip!

What you'll need:

- Cupcake/muffin tin
- Broken crayons
- Vegetable oil
- Toothpick

1. Ask a grown-up to preheat the oven to 275 degrees.
2. Pick out broken crayons in fall colors like orange, yellow, green, red and brown. Remove any labels left on the crayon pieces.
3. Put ¼ teaspoon of vegetable oil into each muffin pan cup.
4. Place broken crayons (no longer than an inch each) into each muffin pan. It should be approximately 1/3 full.
5. Bake crayons for 8 minutes or so, watching carefully as all ovens are different
6. When the crayons begin to melt, remove them from the oven. Stir gently with a toothpick.
7. Your new crayons may look "ugly", like the colors blended too much. Don't worry! They look better on the other side.
8. Cool crayons completely.
9. Pop the crayons out of the muffin pan by tapping on the backside. Then, go and create a masterpiece!

Family Craft Time: Turkey Napkin Holders

Help set the table for Thanksgiving with these adorable Turkey Napkin Holders.

What you need:

- 5- by 7-inch Colorful Poster Board
- Craft Knife
- Double-sided Tape
- Glue Stick
- 2 Googly Eyes (available at craft stores)
- Red and Yellow Construction Paper

1. Cut head and feet shapes in the top and bottom edges of a 5- by 7-inch rectangle of colorful poster board, leaving a 2- by 7-inch center band.
2. Use a craft knife to cut 2 wings near the center of the band.
3. Curl the cardboard by wrapping the ends of the band around something round, such as a rolling pin. Remove the band, overlap the ends, and secure them with double-sided tape.
4. Use a glue stick to attach 2 googly eyes, a red paper wattle, and a yellow paper beak. To adorn each mini tom with fancy feathers, simply fold a colorful napkin accordion style and tuck it inside the ring.
