## Sweet Potato Vine

Don't eat that yummy sweet potato yet - see if it will grow for you!

It's simple!

1. Find a sweet potato with lots buds or eyes.
2. Stick at least three toothpicks into your potato so that it will rest on the edges of a glass jar.
3. Make sure that the small end is down and fill the jar with enough water to keep the bottom of the potato wet.
4. Keep your potato in a sunny window and after several weeks, watch it to grow roots then leaves!
5. Remember to change the water at least once a week.

NOTE: Your sweet potato vines can be planted outside in late May to produce sweet potatoes that can be dug and eaten in the fall.
