DIY PROJECT: SQUIRT GUN PAINTING

Here's what you'll need:

- Squirt gun (or spray bottle)
- Watercolor paper
- Liquid watercolor
- Easel (or thumbtacks)

Directions:

1. Arrange the easel in the yard, then clip two sheets of watercolor paper to each side. Or, you could use a thumbtack to tack the watercolor paper to a tree.
2. Invite your kids to fill their squirt guns with liquid watercolors, then let them go to town painting!
3. Allow the paintings to dry in the grass, weighed down with a rock (if needed).

Pack up your tent, get some marshmallows and spend a weekend in the great outdoors... even if it's in your own backyard.

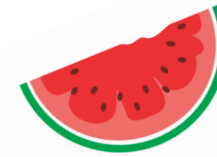


WATER BALLOON OBSTACLE COURSE
