50 FLAVORED POPCORN RECIPES

Who doesn't love freshly popped popcorn, especially on movie marathon nights? Try this S'Mores Popcorn, or check out 49 other flavors from the Food Network at <https://www.foodnetwork.com/recipes/articles/50-flavored-popcorn-recipes>.

S'MORES POPCORN

- 16 cups freshly popped popcorn (microwave or stove top)
- 5 TBSP melted butter
- 2 tsp vanilla extract
- 2 tsp salt
- 2 cups each of mini marshmallows, chocolate chips and lightly crush graham crackers

Whisk the melted butter with the vanilla extract and kosher salt; drizzle over the popcorn. Toss with the mini marshmallows, chocolate chips and graham crackers. Spread on baking sheets and bake at 350 degrees F until the marshmallows and chocolate are slightly melted, about 2 minutes.

and a Bank Manager. This team of people are there to help you in a variety of ways.

- **Tellers:** The tellers stand behind the counter, called the “teller line.” You’ve probably gone to them to deposit money into or withdrawal money out of your account, but they can also help customers get money orders, cashier’s checks and foreign currency, change your address if you move, and more...
- **Personal Banker:** The Personal Banker sits at a desk and can help you open new accounts or apply for loans.
- **Team Supervisor:** The Team Supervisor is there to help the Tellers and Personal Banker, and to assist the Bank Manager.
- **Bank Manager:** The Bank Manager is in charge of the office. They are there to help you as well as the employees in the office.

Tip #2: Learn Names & Develop Relationships

Try to get to know your team of bankers whenever you’re in the office, and they will try to get to know you too! Part of that is being “The Bank of Friendly Service” and getting to know the people in our community, but another part of that is to keep you and your accounts protected. The more we know you, the more we can recognize if someone else is trying to access your account or if something isn’t quite right and can alert you faster.

So the next time you’re in the bank, be sure to say hello!

Tip #3: Let Us Know When You Need Us

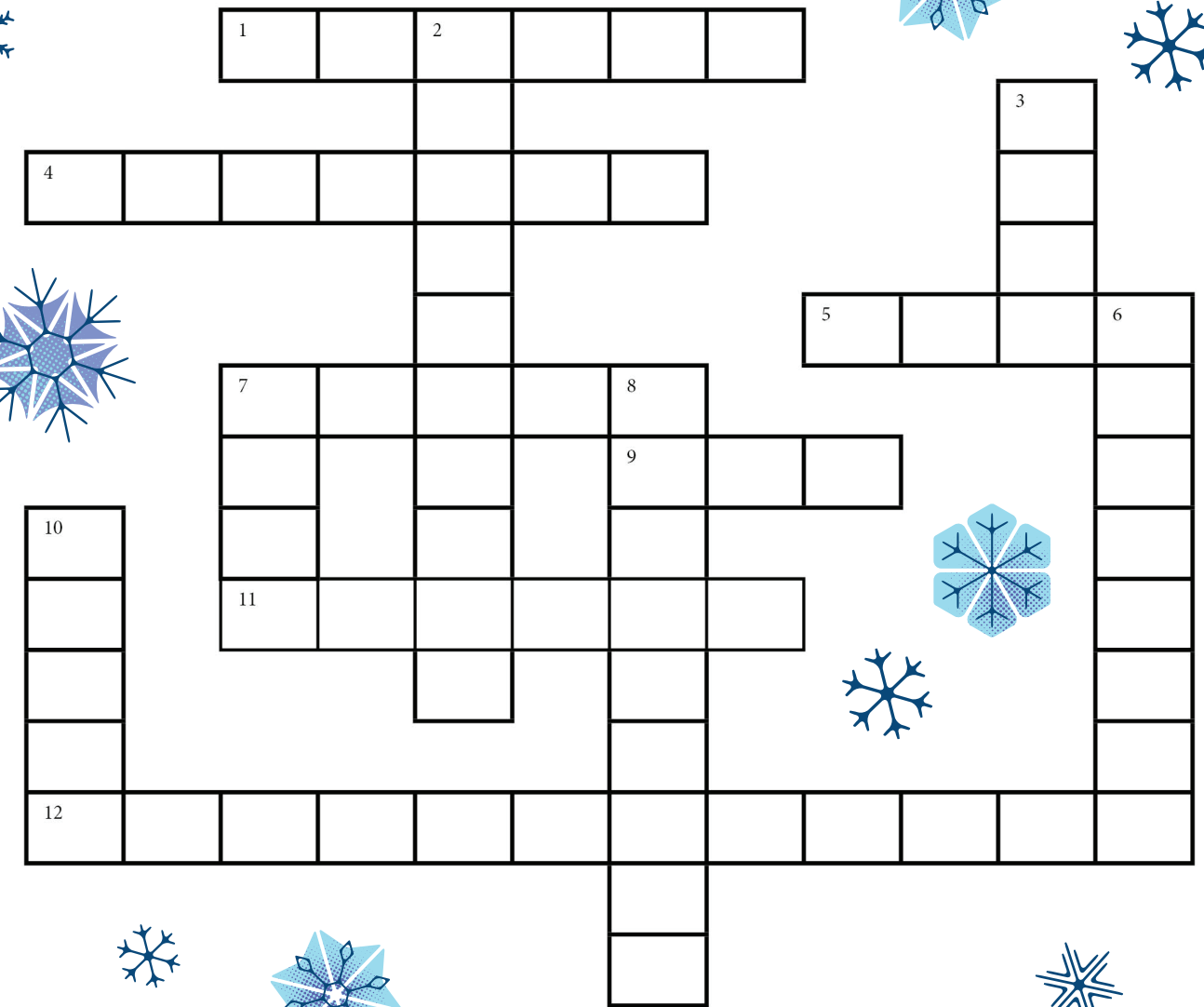
