Let's practice. Look at the items below and circle the things you and your family need. You may have to save up your money for whatever is left over and buy it later.



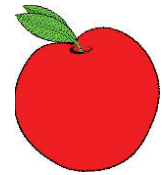

## EGG CARTON PENGUINS

A great craft project for those cold, snowy days! You can make these easily in just a few simple steps with the following supplies: egg carton, black paint, white and orange paper, googly eyes and glue.

1. Trim the "cups" out of the egg carton. Then cut out a beak and feet from orange paper and a belly from white paper.
2. Paint the egg carton cups black and let them dry completely.
3. Glue the white belly onto the little bump that juts out of the egg carton. Then glue on the beak and eyes.
4. Fold the feet to create an edge that you can glue to the inside of the egg cup.

That's it! Now you're ready to have fun with your little penguin friends.

Make Valentine's Day decorations and hang them up around the house.

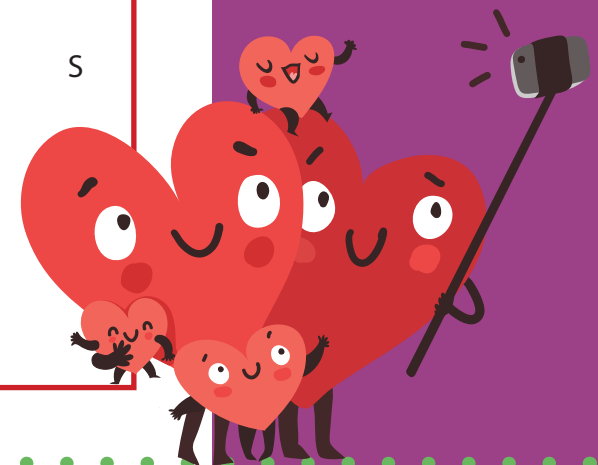
Pop some popcorn and watch a movie.
