WATER BALLOON VOLLEYBALL

How to play:

TRACKING YOUR SAVINGS

Once your parents agree to give you a quarter every day, you can figure out how many quarters you need to buy your toy and track your progress.



We did this by drawing quarters in groups of 4, because we know that 4 quarters = \$1.00. So, if you need \$5.00 for a new toy, make 5 groups of quarters (like we did above). Then count how many quarters there are in all of the groups. This will tell you how many days you need to do your chore in order to buy your new toy. In this case, you would have earned the \$5.00 in 20 days.

REAP THE REWARDS

After you have done your chores and collected your money, you're ready to reap the rewards of all of your hard work! Go out and buy your new toy, or whatever it is you saved up for, and have some fun before the next school year starts.
