DIY: CUSTOM PAINTED SHOES

Grab a pair of white canvas shoes and some paint markers and make your own custom designed shoes!

To make the shoes shown here, this is what you'll need:

- White canvas shoes
- Red and blue paint markers (fine or medium tip)
- Pencil
- Star stencil (if needed)
- Spray sealer (if needed)

How to make them:

1. Use your pencil and the stencil to outline the design on both shoes.
2. Fill in the smaller areas with the fine tip marker and the larger areas with the medium tip marker. Note: You may need to go over areas twice as the canvas material can soak up the paint.
3. If desired, spray sealer over your design to help the paint last longer.

BERRY, LEMON & DOUGHNUT TRIFLE

Help make dessert with this easy trifle.

- 2 cups cold 2% milk
- 1 package (3.4 oz) instant lemon pudding mix
- 1 carton (8 oz) frozen whipped topping, thawed
- 16 to 32 plain doughnut holes
- 3 cups fresh strawberries, halved
- 2 cups fresh blueberries

How to make it:

1. Whisk milk and pudding mix for 2 minutes. Let stand for 2 minutes or until soft-set. Fold in 2-1/2 cups whipped topping; set aside.
2. Place half the doughnut holes in a 3-qt. trifle bowl (or any large glass bowl). Spread half the pudding mixture over the top. Top pudding with half the strawberries and blueberries.
3. Repeat layers and top with remaining whipped topping.
4. Chill until serving.
